Installation

- 1. Go to the Atlassian Marketplace
- 2. Visit the app page for Summary Al Summary Al on Marketplace.
- 3. Click "Get it now" to install the app to your Confluence Cloud instance.
- 4. Simply follow the on-screen instructions to finalize setup.

Getting Started

Using Summary AI is easy and intuitive:

- 1. Navigate to any Confluence page.
- 2. Highlight the text you wish to summarize.
- 3. When the inline menu appears, choose "Summary AI" from the list.
- 4. Instantly view:
 - The word count of the selected portion.
 - An Al-generated summary of the selected content.

Tip: Great for documentation reviews, quick skimming, or content checks.

Built on Atlassian Forge

The app runs entirely within Atlassian's secure Forge environment, ensuring tight integration and compliance with Atlassian's cloud security protocols.

→ No Data Persistence

Selected text is processed in real time and never stored on external servers. We do not log, save, or retain any user content after summarization.

Secure API Usage

Summaries are generated via OpenAl's API using encrypted and anonymized prompts. Your text is transmitted securely over HTTPS and handled only for the purpose of generating a summary.

No Access to Credentials or Metadata

The app does not access, collect, or store user credentials, email addresses, or sensitive page-level metadata from your Confluence instance.
